Program in brief

Research and Training Unit for Prevention and Treatment of Substance Use Disorder, Institute of Clinical Psychology, University of Karachi, organized a one day seminar at the Arts Auditorium, University of Karachi, in Collaboration with Higher Education Commission, Pakistan, on September 26, 2018.
